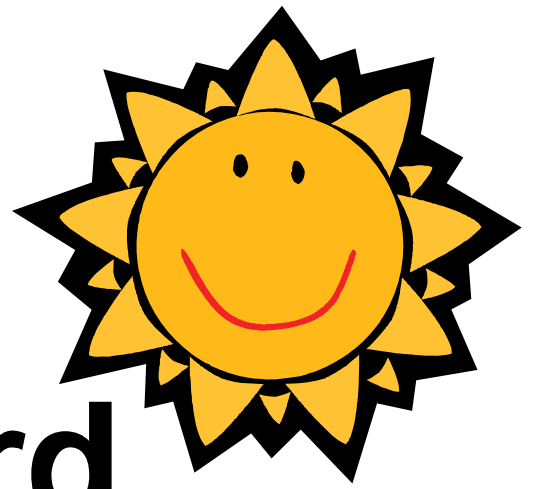

Camp Fees

(Continued from center column on other side)

Weekly Fee—Day camp weekly fees pay for one in County field trip, transportation, and admission fees per week. If a second field trip is planned in that same week, direct costs for transportation and admission are to be charged to each camper whether the field trip is in County or out of County.

Additional fees Apply—If an out of County field trip is planned for the week, the day camp weekly fee would cover transportation to the field trip location, campers would still be charged direct cost for admission into the location/facility. If an additional field trip is planned in the same week as the out of County field trip, direct costs would be charged for transportation and admission.

Late Pickup Fee—\$20.00 per child when picked up 15 minutes or more after conclusion of program.

Enrollment Reservation

Fees must be paid in full weekly before participation in any activity is authorized. Only paid enrollment in any activity constitutes a reservation, unless otherwise stated in program literature. Checks are made payable to Brevard County Parks and Recreation.

Neighborhood Strategy Areas

Residents of identified neighborhood strategy areas shall receive a 50% reduction to rentals and department-sponsored program fees for facilities located within neighborhood strategy areas in which they reside; proof of residency is required.

Program Refund Notice

A processing fee of \$20 will be assessed for refunds. Application for refund must be submitted to the Area office and received prior to scheduled date of use, except for illness or family emergencies, in which case proof must be provided, and the application must be received within seven (7) days following absence. Daily refunds are not available.

Brevard County Board of County Commissioners Parks & Recreation Department

Any person with a disability requiring reasonable accommodation in order to participate in Parks and Recreation Department sponsored activities and programs may call the associated Parks Operations Area Office. For the North Area, call Andrea Chestnut at 321-264-5058. Individual accident medical insurance for participants in programs is not provided by the Brevard County Parks and Recreation Department. Most programs and organized activities require a signed waiver.
