



Winter Camp

Brevard County Parks and Recreation's North Area Parks Operations is offering winter day camps for children entering first grade through eighth grade from Monday, December 20, through Monday, January 3. The camps meet Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. There will be no camp on the following days due to holidays, Friday, December 24, Monday, December 27, and Friday, December 31.

You may register for winter camp at the follow locations: Port St. John Community Center, 6650 Corto Road, Port St. John, North Area Parks Operations, 475 North Williams Avenue, Titusville, Walter Butler Community Center at Bernice G. Jackson Park, 4201 North Cocoa Boulevard, Cocoa, or Cuyler Community Center, 2329 Harry T. Moore Avenue, Mims. Winter Camp will be held at the following locations: Port St. John Community Center, 6650 Corto Road, Port St. John, Sandrift Community Center, 585 North Singleton Avenue, Titusville, and in Sharpes at the Walter Butler Community Center at Bernice G. Jackson Park, 4201 North Cocoa Boulevard, Cocoa, and Cuyler Community Center, 2329 Harry T. Moore Avenue, Mims.

The weekly fee is \$60 per child, with reductions for additional children in the same family. Each camp requires a minimum of 10 participants. A daily rate of \$20 is available when the child is attending three or fewer days during the week.

Extended care is available from 6:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 4 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. The fee for early or late care is \$15 per week or \$7 per time; for early and late care, the fee is \$30 per week or \$12 per day. Late pickup fee (15 minutes after conclusion of program) is \$20.00 per child/per time. Fees are due at the time of registration or on the first day a child attends.
